Lest We Forget



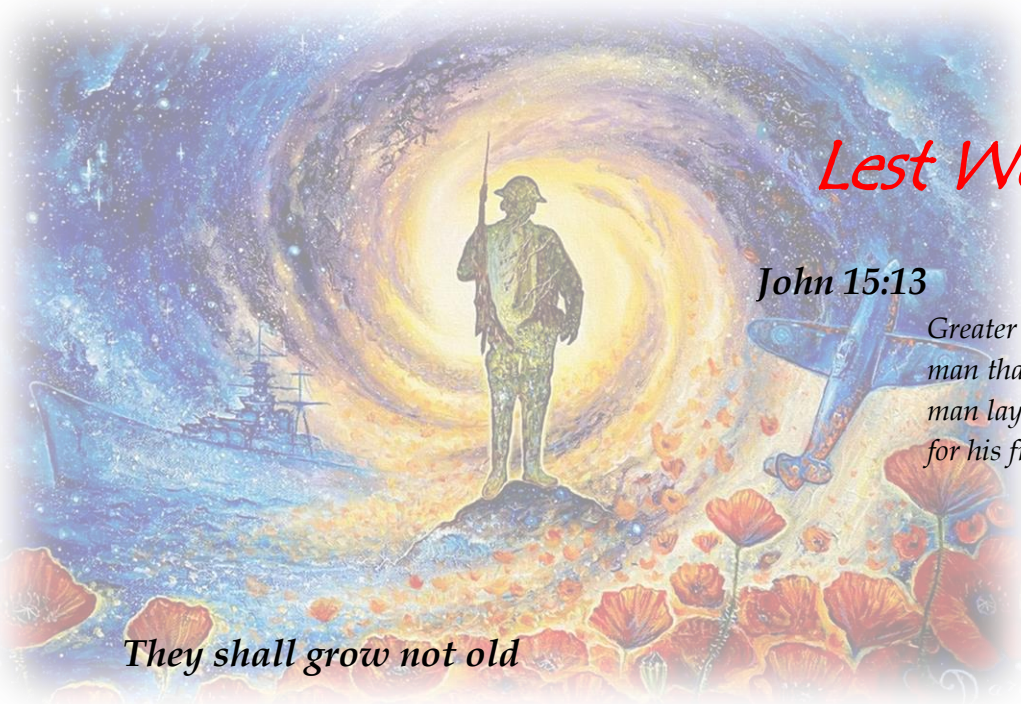
IN FLANDERS FIELDS
